Benjamin Britten's
Rejoice in the Lamb

Ralph Vaughan Williams'
Dona Nobis Pacem

Rejoice in the Lamb, a festival cantata in
four parts, is Britten's classic setting of
the "Jubilate Agno," written by mystic
eighteenth-century English poet
Christopher Smart. Vaughan
Williams' Dona Nobis Pacem was
conceived as a warning against the
gathering clouds of war hovering over
1930s Europe and is his ultimate
choral expression, with the calming
Latin text of the Agnus Dei set against
disturbing and provocative poetry by
Walt Whitman and John Bright.
